**OLD BUSINESS**

1. The minutes of the September, 2018 meeting were read and approved.

## **NEW BUSINESS**

1. The handicap parking spaces at both the upper and lower range are for those who use a wheelchair only.
2. There has been comments made about the difficulty of stapling targets to the shotgun range backstop due to the chains. Members can use a little more flexibility with targets as long as whatever they use—water jugs, clay targets (NOT THROWN) etc.—is cleaned up.
3. A volunteer is needed to run a chainsaw along the left hand side of the 300 yard range to remove overhanging trees so the berm can be seen. Let the board know when this is going to be done so an email can be sent out to notify members that the range will be closed during this time.
4. We have a new cart for hauling wood in from the shed for the lower range. Please do not stack wood in a way that blocks the first lane of the indoor range.
5. There have been issues with members getting locked in after accessing the leased property by others who remove the lock left unlocked. Our lock must remain locked both when you are entering and leaving the property. Please double check this.

6. The club purchased a new golf cart for accessing the 300 yard target area. This cart is only to be used on the gravel path. It is not an all-terrain vehicle.

7. There was a vote taken and passed on the creation of a 50BMG group. Each member of this group is also a range monitor.

8. While ideally, each member of the club is a 'range monitor', we are creating a list of those who would like to volunteer in an official capacity to be alert for dangerous safety violations while at the range. Please let a board member know if you would like to be added to this list. These individuals will report members who either put other individuals in harm's way by their actions, or willfully destroy range property to the board. Range monitors are not strong arm individuals or club 'police officers', but those who are watching for 'major' infractions. Range monitors can be reported by members for aggressive behavior.
